Remote Home Learning - what are we doing?

- 1. Daily Lesson videos by teachers on You Tube and the school website
- 2. Phone calls home to speak to children to assess learning and ask questions
- 3. <u>Weekly remote learning pack posted on the school website every Monday (or printed out and available for collection every Monday from school)</u>
- 4. Online Learning set on purple mash and other class apps e.g. mathletics

In this National Lockdown children will be set between 3-5 hours of learning per day. Children are expected to be learning during normal school hours, so it is important that you try to get them into a routine. Children should be out of bed and ready to start their learning at 9am each day (just like school).

Teachers will be ringing during school hours to offer support to children with their learning and also to assess your child's understanding and progress. As of week beginning: 11th January we will be phoning you 2x per week and we DO need to speak to your child – it is really important that we are able to assess the children so that we can then set work for the following week based on the children's understanding.

Our Remote Home Learning has been designed so that it doesn't have to be completed online. You can access the remote learning pack on our website every Monday or you can collect it from school every Monday – it is the SAME learning. You can read the pack online and then complete the learning in your homework book or you can complete it directly onto the printed pack from school.

We are aware that not all children have access to their own personal device to view the remote learning and so will also be printing them for you. The remote learning packs will be available for collection between 12-2pm every Monday via Gate B - Breakfast Club gate entrance on Colliery Road.

Teachers will also set additional online learning using programmes / apps such as: Purple mash, reading eggs, mathletics etc. Your child will have their log on (and it should be stuck in their homework book) but please do email the email addresses above if you cannot find your child's username or password and we will resend them.

Our school 'You Tube Channel' can be accessed from any XBox, Playstation, SMART TV, phone etc so please start your day with your child watching the daily teacher lesson video.

<u>Free School Meals</u> - Individual children's weekly Lunch Box hampers will be available every Monday 12-2pm via Gate B, Colliery Road. There is currently no National Voucher Scheme available. These lunchbox hampers are for benefit related free school meal children.
