


# This is what we are learning this term

## Our topic is 'Black by Day, Red by Night' Where we will be learning about the Black Country.




This is what we are learning about in each topic:

**English & Reading carousel:** Stories from significant children's authors such as Charles Dickens and Bernie Doherty. Our writing units are film narrative, persuasive writing and poetry.



**Maths:** Fractions and measurement - multiplying fractions, equivalent fractions, decimals, percentages and converting measurements and volume.

**Science:** Forces - we will be learning how to identify and explain the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction.



**History:** The Black Country - how the industrial



revolution affected our local area and looking at how Eastfield, Wolverhampton and the Black Country changed due to the Industrial Revolution.

**Geography:** Locating the parameters of the Black Country and discussing the impact of human and physical features of the Black Country.

**Art:** Drawing and painting through the work of Paul Bloomer and Banksy.



**DT:** Electrical and Electronics (torches) and Mechanics (fairs)

**Languages:** we will continue to learn French through our new interactive French scheme.




**Music:** the history of Mowtown and its importance in the development of Popular music and Western Classical Music

**PE:** Rounders (striking and fielding) and outdoor education (orienteering).

**RE:** What will make Wolverhampton a more respectful place? Looking at the different religions and religious places in the local area.
