## PE - Tuesday and Thursday

Our theme this term is 'Wonder Women'.

English — We are starting the term by writing a set of instructions, and then we will create our very own leaflet about Florence Nightingale. After half term, we explore the author Roger Hargreaves and create our very own Mr Men or Little Miss story. Finally we learn how to write a non-chronological report.

**Maths** — Our focus for this term will be measurement, including money and clocks.

We will also be revising skills we have learnt ready for our SATs.

Science — We will be learning about electrical appliances and their dangers as well as a range of everyday materials, their properties and how they behave when we try to change them.

Art — We will be using textiles to create a 'Wonder Women' cape and learning sketching and drawing skills.

DT — We will be using a range of textiles and joining techniques to create Florence dolls and learning how to design and sew hand puppets.

**Geography** — We will be comparing our local area with the Crimea, a contrasting locality outside Europe. We will also learn about physical and human features and learn to read maps of larger areas.

 $\pmb{\text{History}} - \pmb{\text{We}}$  will be learning about important women in history who were nurses and hospital workers by investigating their lives. We will also be comparing their lives to nurses in the present day.

PE — We will be orienteering. Children will have to read maps and race to find different clues and places. We will also be practising for sports day and learning athletics skills. Our games lessons will be focused on striking balls using small team games.

 $\mathsf{PSHE}-\mathsf{We}$  will be learning about how to deal with making changes in our lives, and learning about the importance of looking after our bodies.

RE- We will be finding out about the 5 Pillars of Islam and different Muslim beliefs.

Computing — Children will explore different ways to create digital

sound and they will learn how to record and edit a simple film clip.

Homework/spellings — Homework and spellings will be given out on a Friday and should be returned by

the following Thursday.
